

## Change contract name after selling or renting

Contract holders are liable for all expenses of the electricity supply contract. Upon selling or renting your premises, the new owner/tenant should change the contract name to his/her name, otherwise current owner remains liable for all expenses of the premise. Contractual liabilities only end after a contract ends.

Changing the contract name would give new owners/tenants access to a variety of benefits, including but not limited to e-services such as billing management, bill checking, consumption monitoring, and more.



## Be prepared for the typhoon season

To protect citizens and speed up the repair afterwards, CEM may implement power suspension in low-lying areas based on storm surge warnings and flood conditions. Take the following measures to prepare for typhoons: close all your doors and windows, do not place appliances near windows, and prepare a rechargeable flashlight. Should a flood occur, turn off the main switchboard immediately, and do not touch any soaked power facilities.
